

Using your DS series printer driver for the Macintosh computer

After installing your driver, you can the DS40 or DS80 to print from your computer.




Note: the printer options screen may change slightly depending on the program from which you are printing. Graphic design programs like *Photoshop* or *Illustrator* may have extra settings which are not included in the examples below.



Attention: The examples that follow show settings for the DS80 computer. The DS40 printer control panels are the same, but will use different sizes for the paper.


Exploring the control panel




Letter	Description	Letter	Description
a	Select Printer*	h	Overcoat type: glossy/matte
b	Preset Selection	i	Resolution (300x300 dpi – DO NOT CHANGE)
c	Copies/Collated	j	Sharpness
d	Print Pages: all/selection	k	Gamma Correction
e	Paper Size	l	Contrast
f	Paper Orientation	m	Brightness
g	Printer Settings	n	preview window

*selecting a different printer, such as the DS40, will change some of the options (paper size) accordingly.

By Clicking on the **Color** button, you can change the controls from **General** controls to the Color controls.


